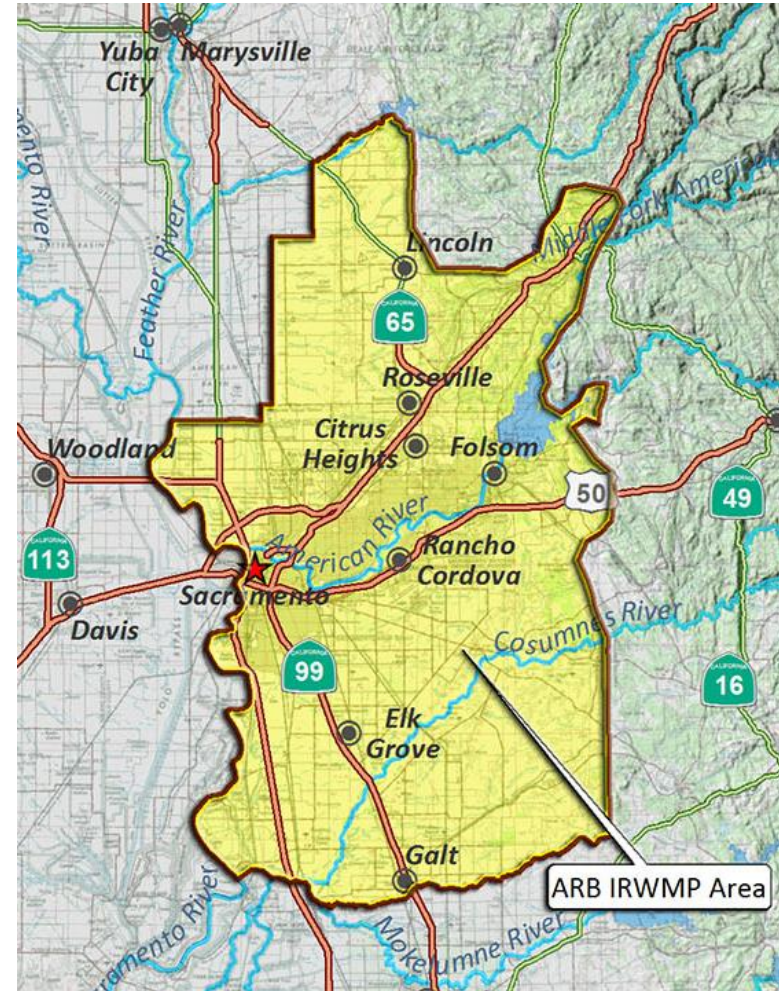
2018 Update Process

- Public draft released April 23, 2018, followed by a 30-day public comment period

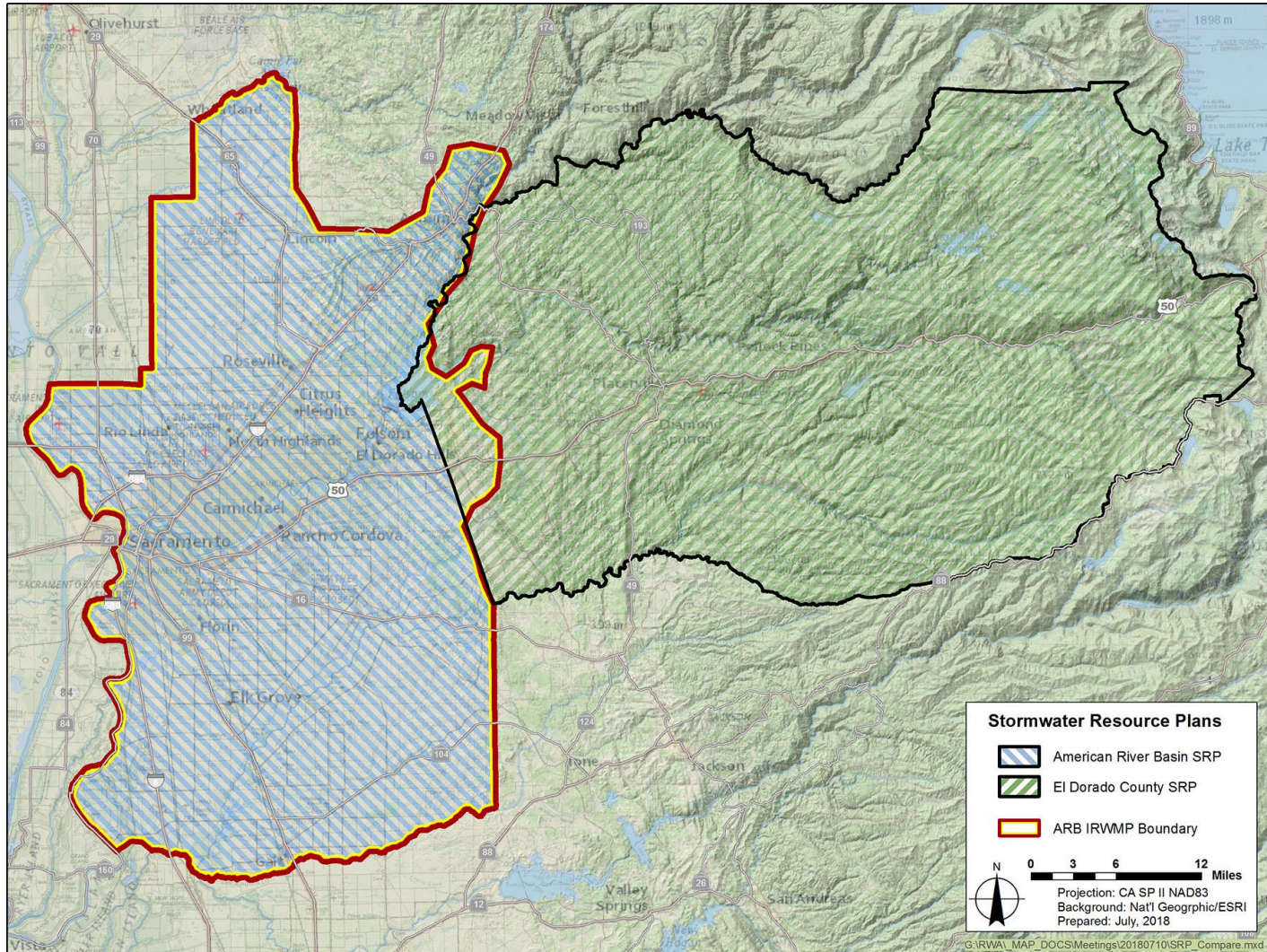


Highlights of Changes from 2013 ARB IRWMP
