NOTICE OF INTENT TO PREPARE AN UPDATE TO AN INTEGRATED REGIONAL WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN

The Regional Water Authority (RWA) will hold a public meeting on July 12, 2018 to consider adopting an Integrated Regional Water Management Plan (IRWMP) for most of Sacramento County and the western portions of Placer and El Dorado counties. RWA is a joint powers authority of more than 20 water suppliers and is the designated entity to prepare an IRWMP in the lower American River Basin.

The IRWMP is a planning document that establishes a framework for sustainable water resource planning to benefit the community, economy, and environment. The IRWMP identifies and prioritizes projects that provide multiple benefits for water supply, water quality, flood management, ecosystem improvement, and recreation.

The public meeting will be held beginning at 9 a.m., at the RWA (5620 Birdcage St, Ste 110, Citrus Heights, CA, 95610).
