Mr. Peifer said that support or comments on the draft proposal Stream Act are due Friday, March 18, 2022. Opinions and comments on the bill would be appreciated. He suggested meeting with legal counsel to initiate a position letter on the draft proposal noting that RWA looks forward to working with the Senator on the bill by the deadline and have the Executive Committee affirm the position at their next meeting.

7. Federal Legislative Review – Potential action may be taken

a) FY 22 Budget Timeline & FY23 kick off

Mr. Sapirstein said that it will be August or September timeframe before the State Revolving Loan Fund monies are disbursed. There is a hearing before Environment and Public Works on the allocation formula for the State Revolving Loan Fund program. Ms. More said there is historical knowledge and background on how funds have been administered.

b) Bipartisan Infrastructure Law – water provisions summary

Ms. More said there is significant funding coming from a lot of different categories in the infrastructure package.

c) WRDA Section 219 Work Group Status

Ms. More gave an update on Section 219 issues, the appropriations process, recommendations, and guidelines that request specific project authorization or specific language. For Section 219, the environmental infrastructure, members were limited to five different project requests. Reimbursement will be received from the Corps out of the appropriated funds for Section 219.

d) Arrearage funding - LIHWAP

Mr. Ojakian said that there was reference to dedicated funding for disadvantaged and underserved communities.

Ms. More said that applications must address how the project will benefit disadvantaged and underserved communities. Applicants need to be able to support the information in the application.

8. WIIN Act Funding for Water Bank Status

Issue a letter of support for the draft proposal Stream Act.

Follow up with FY 23 earmarked process as a region and as individual agencies.

More on funding issues that agencies are planning to pursue on drinking water and wastewater.
