
WATER EFFICIENCY & CONSERVATION PLAN- WILL BE UPDATED IN 2024

- First created in 2013, tied to SBX7-7 (20% by 2020 targets)
- How will we achieve a 19% reduction by 2030?











REBATES-OUTDOOR (SF)

- >\$1.50/square foot front yard turfgrass rebate, up to 2,000 sq ft
- >\$400 smart irrigation controller rebate
- >\$400 irrigation upgrade rebate
- >\$150 rain barrel rebate
- >\$100 graywater rebate: laundry to landscape







LANDSCAPE DESIGN ASSISTANCE


16 Landscape Designers listed

\$200 rebate, tied to front yard turf conversion






IRRIGATION UPGRADES






TURFGRASS TRANSFORMATION: 2014 TO PRESENT





SMART CONTROLLER REBATES





LEAK FREE SACRAMENTO

Added Low income customers from non –DAC areas- SURA

Increasing the cap on repair amount per customer – Increased it to \$7,000 (from max. \$4,000)

Allowing wider range of projects – e.g. foundation slab

Will be funding 40-50 projects a year







LEAK REPAIR ASSISTANCE (LRA) REBATE

Rebate is either \$250 or \$500- if leak is 20 GPH or greater

Leak investigation required \$40,000 budget this FY
