3.0 2024-2025 Grant Application Discussion

WEP has been looking into upcoming grant opportunities. USBR WaterSmart Grant appears to be a good fit for the program. Based on the criteria we may qualify for direct installation, turf replacement, public outreach and potentially more funding for the brewery partnership. The current direct installation program will be used for 50% local cost share requirement. There was universal support for proceeding.
There was a recommendation for single family homes to be included in the direct installation program. The current the cost/benefit does not align for installation for single family homes. There is a potential to include more flexibility and potentially include HOAs.

4.0 Program Updates	
New CIMIS Station	A new CIMIS station is being installed in Elk Grove. Maintenance will be conducted by Sacramento County Water Agency. RWA is still looking for a good site in the northern part of our region. The Auburn station is old and no longer in a good location. Linda (PCWA) would like to discuss relocating the station with DWR. Amy will make email connection for Linda and DWR.
QWEL and CLIA	The QWEL program fees are increasing. We currently hold one class per year in October. We have discussed holding a Spanish class; however, we need a marketing plan before moving forward. Contact Monica if you are interested in participating in an Ad Hoc Committee to create a marketing strategy for a Spanish QWEL class.
	RWA is hosting a CLIA exam on January 24, 2025. Don Franklin will conduct a review before the exam. Information will be sent out once the Irrigation association adds it to their calendar.
Brewery Partnership	Max McSlavkin will be working on this program via IN Communications (Christine). He has been reaching out to breweries in the Sacramento and Auburn areas to increase our promotional partnerships with breweries.

Mulch Mayhem Check in	This topic will be addressed at the November RWEPAC meeting.
Nippon Shokken Promotion	RWA provided grant funded rebates to Nippon Shokken. A case study article was created and will be expanded to a video in partnership with DWR. If one of your commercial customers has made water saving changes, contact Amy. We would like to start promoting the investments in the region.
Sacramento Tree Foundation Buckets	There was a miscommunication with the Sacramento Tree Foundation about the number of tree watering buckets available for distribution (couple hundred versus thousands). WEP decided not to place an order for buckets to make up the difference.
Conservation Regulation and Nurseries	Joanna Solins (UC Cooperative Extension) is presenting about the conservation regulation at an upcoming nursery conference and asked the RWEPAC what information we think plant/tree growers should know about the regulation and how it might impact nursery plant/tree demands.
