












AMI LEAK LETTERS FY 2016-2025





LEAK FREE SACRAMENTO- SINCE 2018

Eligibility: single family homeowners& duplexes with leaks 25+ gph either residing in the –DAC areas or SURA

Increasing the cap on repair amount per customer – \$7,000

Most projects involve a customer main replacement, but some do involve hot water line repairs

Goal to fund 40-50 projects a year:



LEAK REPAIR ASSISTANCE REBATE

- \$250 maximum rebate if leak is < 25 GPH
- \$500 maximum rebate is leak is 25+ GPH
- Leak investigation required
- \$40,000 budget this fiscal year- 25 rebates
 to date this FY, I I 9 since late 202 I










GRASS CONVERSION REBATE-CHANGES COMING SOON

- Maximum rebate of \$3,000
- **Up to \$1.50** per square foot of grass converted
- 2,000 square foot maximum-single family
- Front, back and side yards are eligible
- Rebate up to \$200 also available for front yard landscape design assistance-single family-18 LDAs on list
- Can hand water or install drip
- Will be changing our plant list to drop moderate water use plants





TURFGRASS TRANSFORMATION: 2014 TO PRESENT





IRRIGATION UPGRADE REBATE

Converting sprinkler systems to drip irrigation

- Water delivered slowly to roots either from above the soil surface or buried below
- Minimal evaporation and runoff

Converting standard pop-up sprinklers to rotating nozzles

- More uniformly delivers water at a low application rate
- Significantly reduces runoff









SMART CONTROLLER REBATES













LOW INCOME SINGLE FAMILY TOILET DIRECT INSTALL PILOT

- ▶46 uHETs, 5 angle stops and 2 showerheads installed at 37 homes
- Extension of pilo the end of 2025
- >\$50,000 budget

Non Functional turf legislation

Overall City water budget tightens up significantly in 2030,
