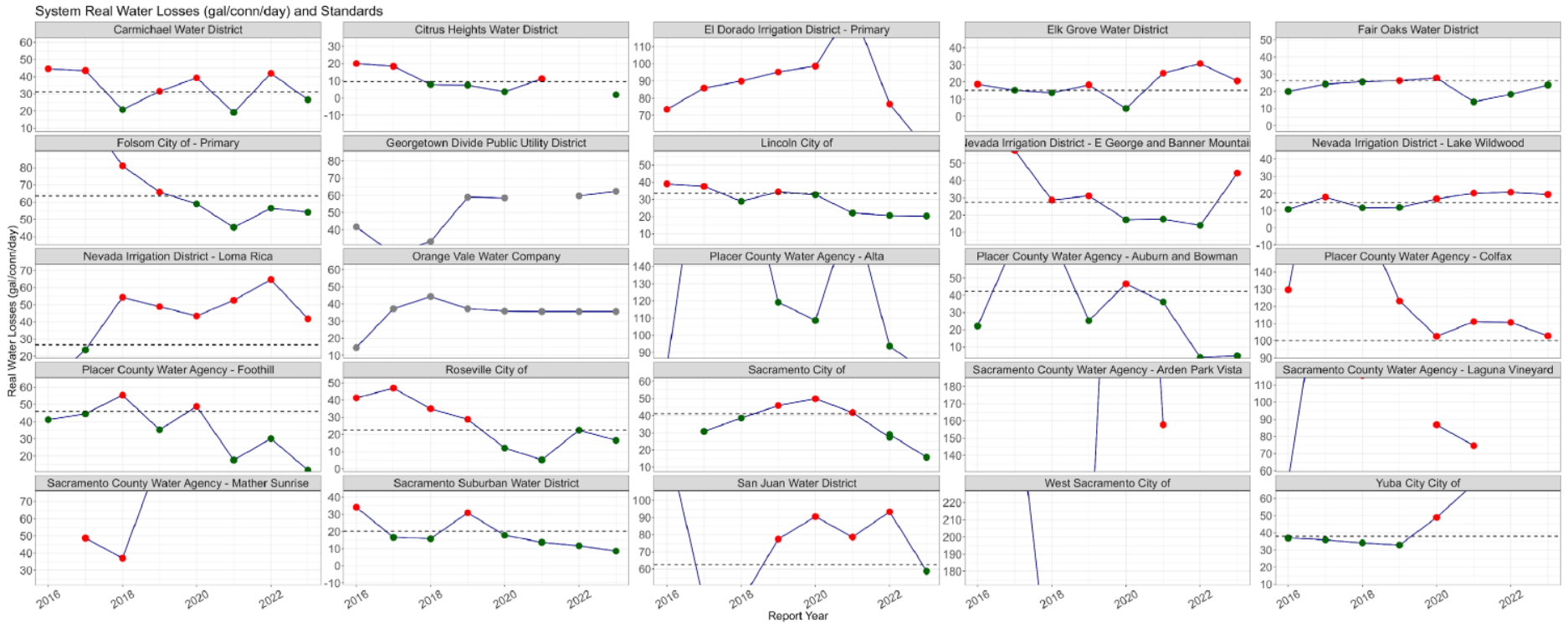

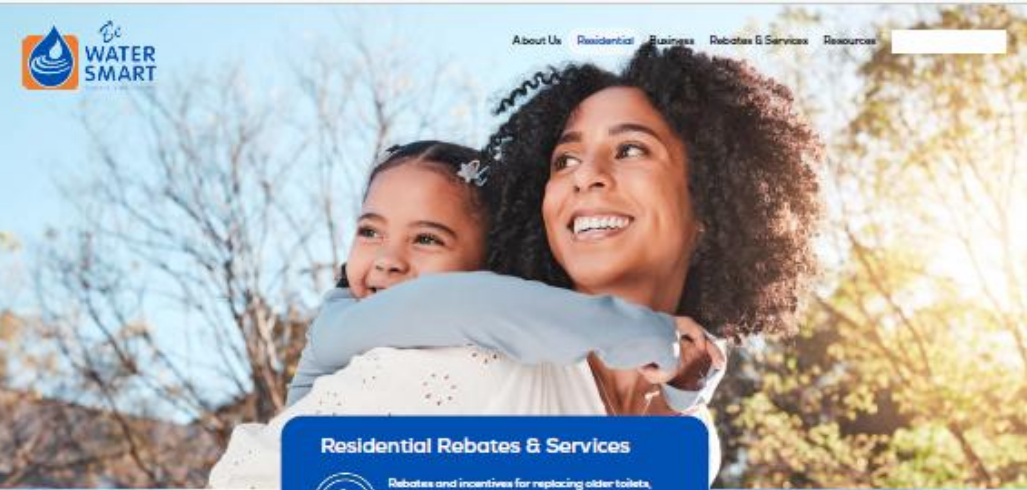

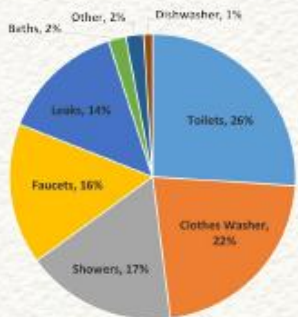

## Services and Advice for Water Smart Use Inside Your Home

In the Sacramento region, about 45 percent of a household's water use is indoors - most of that in the bathroom. Toilets alone account for more than a quarter of a household's water use, followed by clothes washers (22 percent of indoor water use), showers (17 percent), faucets (16 percent) and leaks (14 percent).



## Are you Water Smart? Water Calculator

### Why should I replace my clothes washer?

Clothes washers account for about 20% of all indoor water use. How many loads do you do a year? The average family does 300 loads of laundry. That's about 12,000 gallons a year! If you wash clothes in hot or warm water, you are also using additional energy. Participating water providers are offering rebates from \$50 to \$175 to residential customers who purchase and install a new, qualifying high-efficiency clothes washer. More money may also be available from your energy provider. We recommend purchasing an ENERGY STAR certified clothes washer. ENERGY STAR clothes washers use 20% less energy and 35% less water than less efficient models. If you want to save the most energy, look for the ENERGY STAR Most Efficient models. Now you can save water, energy and money, and get cash back as well.

### Why should I replace my toilet?

Toilets account for more than 25% of all indoor water use. Toilets manufactured before 1992 use 3.5 to 7 gallons per flush (gpf) or better than 17,000 and 34,000 gallons per year. By replacing your 3.5 gpf or greater toilet with a 1.28 gpf High Efficiency Toilet (HET) toilet, a family can save approximately 17,000 gallons per year. We recommend purchasing a WaterSense toilet. WaterSense toilets are third party tested to ensure performance while saving water.

Customers of participating water providers are eligible to receive up to \$175 rebate for replacing a 3.5-gallon per flush (gpf) or greater toilet with a new High Efficiency Toilet (HET) which flushes 1.28 gpf or less. Rebate levels depend on the water provider and funding available. Call your water provider to determine your rebate eligibility and amount of rebate.

### Restaurants / Food Service

Restaurants use the dishwasher and energy wash to save high-temperature high-pressure water. Use the lowest possible temperature and cycle. The results reduce the amount of hot water used to pre-heat dishes for the dishwasher. Restaurants also have made the switch to biodegradable dishwashers and floor mats. Biodegradable mats are made of 100% recycled plastic.

Restaurants can also reduce water by replacing older water and controls with high-efficiency water controls, used for heating and cooling for hotels.


